

- The entity or school must be licensed and registered with the relevant authorities in the country.




#### **Evaluation Criteria**

• Organizing and preparing (permits - providing of needs - health and safety rules...).

• The time period taken to implement the voluntary initiative (number of hours - number of days).

- Supervision and follow-up (task distribution, task execution thru initiatives, number of volunteers).
- Documentation in the submitted file (photos and attachments).
- Commitment to social work ethics.
- Implementing the initiative (participation, building relationships and cooperation, presenting distinguished initiatives to support volunteering).



- Planning (clear goals and action plan, identification of needs, roles and permits, meetings).
- Creativity (innovation that serves the field of volunteering).



- Achievement of goals (performance evaluation reports).
- · Amount and size of benefit and advantage from the initiative (number of beneficiaries - frequency of activities - reports of benefit and customer satisfaction).









The total number of winners is 9 divided as 3 winners for each category (governmental - private - NGOs) Categories or positions that did not meet the conditions and evaluation criteria are excluded.



The award is an appreciation presented by the Sharjah Award for Voluntary Work at a special ceremony to honor the winners of the sustainable volunteering competition.
